

**RESOLUTION #2024-99
AMENDMENT #8
TO
CURRY COUNTY INDIGENT HOSPITAL CLAIMS POLICY
ADOPTED FEBRUARY 18, 2003 BY RESOLUTION #2003-06**

WHEREAS, Curry County has previously adopted its Indigent Hospital Claims Policy as Resolution #2003-06; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution has previously been amended, most recently by Amendment #7, Resolution #2024-32, adopted March 12th, 2024, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to current statutory guidelines, Curry County desires to amend Section II. IHC Eligibility Provision, G. Medical Treatment Eligibility and Payment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that existing Section II. IHC Eligibility Provision, G Medical Treatment Eligibility and Payment be amended to include Optometry and Vision Care Services by contracted provider.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a new subsection, G(1)(h), is added to include Optometry and Vision Care Services by contracted provider.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a new term under Glossary, number 28, will be **Optometry and Vision Care Services** to be defined as follows: The practice or profession of examining the eyes for visual defects and prescription of treatment and/or corrective lenses to include: eye exams for adults; eye exams for children; diabetic eye exams; detection exams for eye disease; glasses (frames not more than once per two (2) year period and glasses not more than once per year); contact lens fitting; and management of eye diseases, including cataracts, glaucoma, diabetic retinopathy, macular degeneration, urgent eye injuries and minor to severe eye irritations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the above referenced language of the above referenced Section of the Curry County Indigent Hospital Claims Policy be and hereby are amended effective the 1st day of January, 2025.


